The Bureau of Land Management and California Historic Route 66 Association will seek a National Scenic Byway/All American Road designation for this segment of California Route 66 from the Federal Highway Administration when a nomination period is announced. Route 66 extends 2,448 miles across eight states from Chicago, Illinois to Santa Monica, California. Currently, Route 66 in Arizona, Illinois, New Mexico, and Oklahoma have obtained this designation.

CHR66A and the BLM look forward to collaborating with the County of San Bernardino, the cities of Barstow and Needles, American Indian Tribes and stakeholders throughout the state as we implement the CMP to preserve the history and nostalgia of Route 66 in California and promote sustainable heritage tourism.
